Subject: Clarification on Conducting Closed Online Trainings

Following the February 1st, 2024 notice, here are key clarifications for closed online training:

- 1. Eligibility: Online delivery is permitted only if all trainees are located in different locations. Ex: Organization XYZ with branches in A, B, and C different cities/locations can request online training for employees across those cities/locations.
- 2. Request Process: Training partners must submit a request letter 7 days before the training date using the prescribed format. They have to upload the letter on the portal for verification and approval by the FoSTaC team.
- 3. Course Applicability: Closed online training is allowed for basic and advanced courses, but not for awareness courses.
- 4. Fee: The fee for closed online training is 25% less than the fee prescribed for regular courses.

5. Participant Limits:

i. Basic courses:

Maximum of 1000 participants online, 100 offline.

ii. Advance courses:

Maximum of 100 participants for online and 40 offline.

Note: Advanced course limit remains unchanged.
